Students interested in submitting work to any of the following publications should first familiarize themselves with the style and content of the magazine. Next, contact the publication for their submission guidelines—some can be found on line but most require mailing a request. Always include a SASE (#10, self-addressed, stamped envelope) with any written correspondence. It may take several months to receive a response after submitting your writing. And remember, even professional writers receive rejections, so don't be discouraged if it takes multiple submissions before you get published. Simply write, write and write some more...
